

At age 9, Rik Montero discovered a love for hip-hop that would fuel his rise to becoming a successful rapper. He shared the stage with major artists and gained prominence on some of rap's biggest platforms, like Hot 97 FM and The Source magazine.

His pinnacle moment as an artist came when he earned a Gold plaque for his collaboration with Fat Joe on the Cradle 2 the Grave soundtrack. However, an invitation to church by his barber in 2005 would soon change everything. Rik had been consumed with the fast-paced lifestyle that came with his success, focusing on pursuing money and fame. But his encounter with God led to his decision to end his secular career in favor of rapping for Christ. Inspired by his faith, Rik would go on to establish a Christian clothing line (Proclaim Clothing) with his wife Irsi, as well as establish Christ Jam, an organization focused on empowering youth through music.

Today, as a servant of Jesus, family man and dedicated artist, Rik's journey continues to exemplify the redemptive power of faith.

Jena Fisher

Director/Producer/Soloist

Jena is the Multisite Worship Director and the principal worship leader at Christ Church. She has performed in numerous Christmas productions. 
professional writing from CUNY Lehman College, with a minor in Music. She aims to fulfill two goals in life: becoming a voiceover actress and a writer of children's books.


